

# Auburn — 8.3 Miles



## Auburn Segments

- 10 Danville Junction to Downtown (7.6 Miles, Route TBD).** The rail trail on the Berlin Subdivision rail corridor ends at Danville Junction, near the New Gloucester-Auburn border. The route from there to downtown Auburn is to be determined, but the Auburn community is engaged in a redevelopment of the entire route 202 corridor into Auburn, and active transportation is a key aspect of their municipal planning.
- 11A Auburn Riverwalk (0.7 Miles, Completed).** As highlighted on trailink, the Auburn Riverwalk passes through the heart of the old mill district of the Twin Cities of Auburn and Lewiston. The paved and gravel path offers many scenic views of the Androscoggin River, the powerhouse that fueled the historic mill industry.
