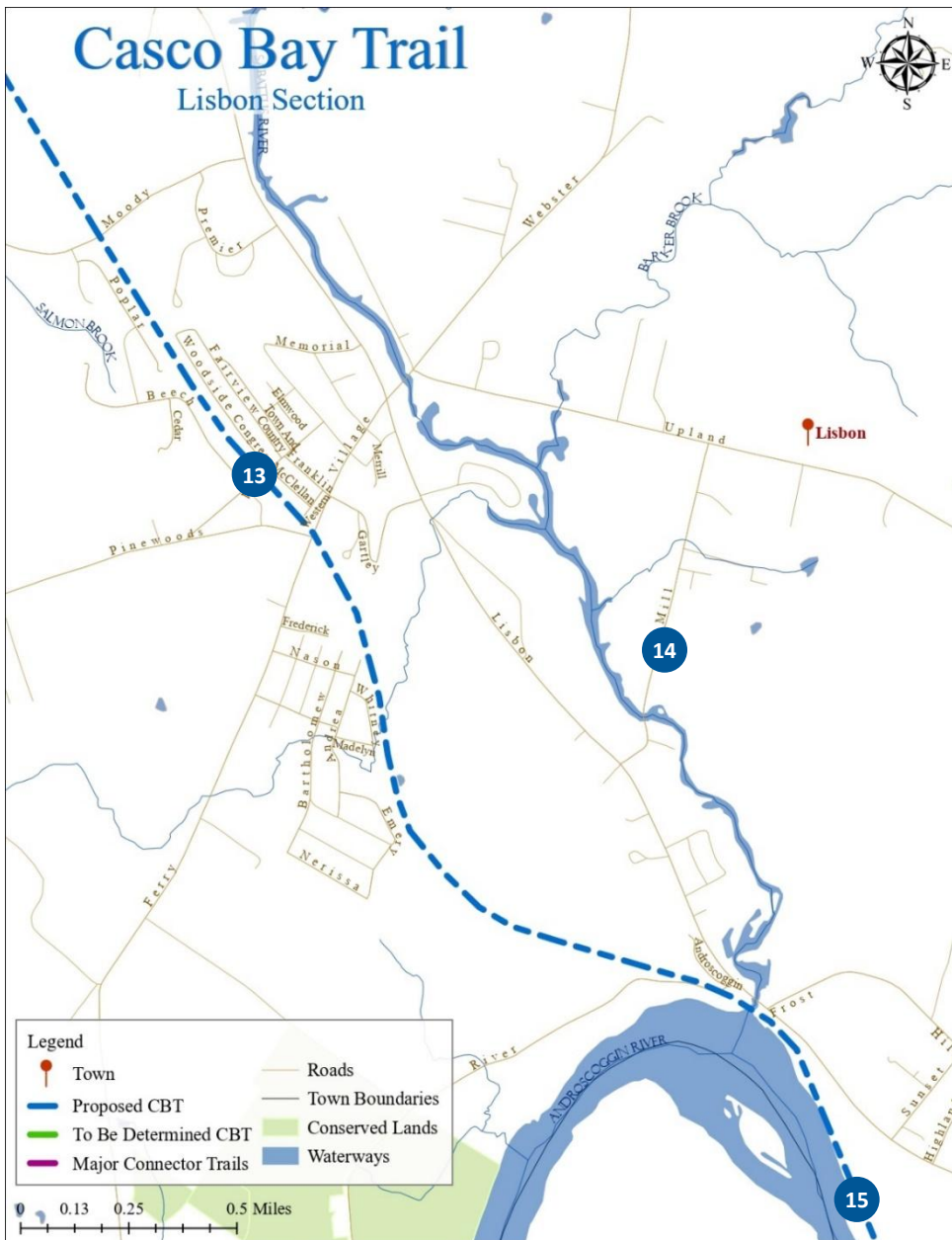


# Lisbon — 7.2 Miles



## Lisbon Segments

**Auburn Border to Papermill Trail (3.6 Miles, Negotiations in Process).** This segment is located on the inactive Lewiston Lower Rail corridor. It has been envisioned as a rail trail for 25 years. The corridor is owned by CSX, and the Lewiston-Auburn Railroad Company (owned by the cities of Lewiston and Auburn) is discussing with CSX the possibilities for using the corridor as a trail. A preliminary engineering assessment has been conducted by Sebago Technics.

**Papermill Trail (2.6 Miles, Completed).** This existing paved trail runs along the Sabattus and Androscoggin Rivers and through fields and woods in the town of Lisbon and Lisbon Falls.

**Papermill Trail to Topsham Border (1.0 Miles, RUAC In Process).** This segment is located on the unused state-owned Lewiston Lower Rail Corridor. A MaineDOT Rail Use Advisory Council is evaluating its potential trail use.
